Recipe of the Month Quick Turkey Chili Heat 1 tablespoon olive oil in a medium skillet over medium-high heat. Add 1 small yellow onion, chopped and cook, stirring, until slightly soft, about 4 minutes. Add 1 pound ground turkey and cook, crumbling with the back of a wooden spoon, until no trace of pink remains, 5 to 7 minutes. Add 1 14.5-ounce can diced tomatoes and their juices, 1 15.5-ounce can kidney beans, rinsed and drained, 1 bell pepper, diced, 3 tablespoons tomato paste, 1½ cups water, 1 1/2 teaspoons chili powder, and 1¼ teaspoons salt. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat and simmer until slightly thickened, about 15 minutes. Divide among bowls and top with the sour cream, Cheddar, and onion, if using.
