Recipe of the Month Chipotle Zesty Dipping Sauce Recipe Add 2 peeled cloves garlic, 2 cups yogurt, 2 Tbsp lemon juice, 2-3 in chipotle pepper in adobo sauce, 1 pinch granulated sugar, 3/4 tsp garlic powder, 1/2 tsp onion powder, 1/2 tsp kosher salt, 1/4 tsp pepper, to a blender or food processor then puree until completely smooth. Make sure there are no lumps of garlic or bits of chipotle chili remaining. Garnish with a dash of paprika if desired. Transfer to an airtight container and refrigerate for a minimum of 1 hour to meld flavors. Sauce will keep in the refrigerator for up to a week. Enjoy!
