Shooting will start at 6 pm and run as long as needed to get all the teams shot or 10 pm whatever comes first. As of now plan on shooting Thursdays because Sundays will be by appointment for make-ups due to lack of help for that day. We will do what is needed to accommodate make-ups but please plan on Thursdays.

League Fees To speed up shooting on the first night Pam will be at the club to collect league and shooting fees at 4:30. The best thing to do is have a check made out to the Swamp Road Sportsman's Club for \$100. That's 80 dollars for 10 weeks of shooting and 20 dollars for a shooting fee. Don't confuse the shooting fee with the membership fee. A shooting fee is for everyone that shoots and is a one-time fee that allows you to shoot all trap and rifle leagues for the year.
