**Recipe of the Month** *Garlic Beef.* In a 12-inch nonstick skillet, heat 1 tsp of sesame oil over high heat. Add 1-pound eye of round, 10 oz package of frozen chopped broccoli, 1 tsp of minced garlic, 2 tsp of light soy sauce, 5.3 grains of green dot, and ½ tsp ground black pepper. Cook 18 to 20 minutes until the beef is fully cooked. Serve hot and it will serve 4 people.
